Regional Supervision Alabama explores regional supervision. First area agent named in 1993. Success leads to addition of 6 area agents in 1995.

Youth EFNEP Begins

Volunteers in 10 counties implement 4-H D.O.T. (Diet's Our Thing) curriculum in January 1970. 4-H D.O.T. is statewide by 1977 as 57 counties are added. Part-time educators hired in 1979.

Cook-It Alabama moves away from one-on-one teaching and toward small-group teaching with Cook-It

First Federal Appropriation

Through the USDA, Congress appropriates \$10 million nationwide. Pilot Project becomes known as the Expanded Food and Nutrition Education Program (EFNEP).

Pilot Project Alabama, Massachusetts, Missouri, Rhode Island, and Texas selected to pilot EFNEP. Auburn University implements pilot project on July 1, 1964, to June 30, 1969.


